### 2. Acceptance for the course:

Applying for the course does not automatically mean you are accepted. Final acceptance will be announced on your personal USOSweb profile on 1 March 2019. Please then check your USOSweb account whether you have been accepted into the course or not.

Acceptance into the course will be decided based on the ranking list and the time of online registration. The assigned ranking determines the priority (in case the number of interested students is higher than the number of places available).

The following ranking list affects the result of the registration **WSM.IE.EN3-18/19L**:

- Rank 5: Students enrolled in the fee-based BA and SA programmes at the Centre for European Studies
- Rank 4: Students on Erasmus and other exchanges at IE, students enrolled in other international programmes;
- Rank 3: All BA students of the Institute of European Studies
- Rank 2: International Students who belong to any other Department of Jagiellonian University
- Rank 1: Other students who belong to any other Department of Jagiellonian University

**PLEASE NOTE: courses can only be taken for credit, NOT audited.** Students must actively participate in the course and complete the required coursework, readings and other preparations, as prescribed in the course syllabus.

### 3. Withdrawal:

Students who decide not to attend a course in which they are enrolled may withdraw after the registration finishes under the condition that the Director of Institute of European Studies, dr hab. Krzysztof Koźbiał, agrees to the student's request (via written 'petition' letter). A petition with a suitable request should be submitted no later than 30 days from the beginning of the semester to the contact person (either IE Office, at ul. Ingardena 3 or CES Office at ul. Garbarska 7a). Please be advised that NZAL (niezaliczenie = fail) will be entered in the student's records if he/she does not receive permission to withdraw and will not take the final exam.
